shadowline handles and benchtop thickness variations of 40mm to 110mm. The lighter colour scheme catches the eye with a touch of natural timber in the benchtop legs, while the recessed overhead cabinet introduces a third colour, creating a stunning yet understated visual combination.

For the final touch, the lighting of the breakfast bar, above and below the recessed wall cabinets, gives a clean, spacious look to match the open plan of the home and allow for the practicality in meeting the needs of the family. There's an array of top-branded appliances, such as Smeg, Omega, Bosch and Westinghouse, and extras including a cutlery insert and hidden microwave. These touches combined with the flawless design of this modern kitchen mean the owners couldn't have possibly asked for more.
